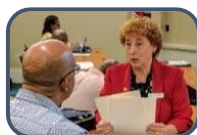

Research finds:



- Only one quarter of principals (25%) participating in this Virginia survey responded that they had been offered coaching and mentoring by their school divisions. *Principal Attrition, Retention and Mobility Study* (2020)
- Nationally, up to 50% of new principals leave by year 5 due, in part, to lack of support. *Churn: The High Cost of Principal Turnover* (2014)
